



2018 OES Wages Now Available on Discover Arkansas

The Arkansas Division of Workforce Services' Labor Market Information (LMI) department is pleased to announce the 2018 occupational wage release on Discover Arkansas. Using responses from thousands of employers and aggregating the data to protect confidentiality, we are able to estimate the average hourly and annual wages for over 800 occupations statewide. In addition, the website www.Discover.Arkansas.gov allows users to compare occupational wages across all Arkansas Metropolitan Statistical and Workforce Development areas.
