


while 530 are from people changing jobs. Growth and expansion accounts for 148 annual openings.

The *Architects, Surveyors, and Cartographers* occupational family is anticipating 22 new jobs, an increase of 1.56 percent. Surveyors is predicted to increase employment by 10 jobs, or 2.09 percent gain. The occupational family is expecting around 111 annual job openings.

The *Engineers* occupational family is slated to add 180 new jobs between 2018 and 2020, more than 60 percent of the gain in **Architecture and Engineering Occupations.** Industrial Engineers leads in this group with an increase of 63 jobs. Around 539 annual job openings are anticipated.

The *Drafters, Engineering Technicians, and Mapping Technicians* occupational family is anticipating a net gain of 95. Electrical and Electronics Engineering Technicians is estimated to lead the occupational family with 17 new jobs. The occupational family as a whole is forecast to experience 321 annual job openings.
